Why Curiosity Matters



Builds Understanding

Encourages Creativity

Promotes Empathy

When we're curious about others' experiences, it helps us to care and connect.



Supports Learning

Curious minds stay active, engaged and motivated in school and beyond.

Curiosity helps to bridge differences and spark conversation

Curiosity and Inclusivity Go Hand-in-Hand

When we're curious about people's cultures, languages, traditions and stories, we build respect and understanding to better appreciate one another.

Curiosity reminds us that **everyone** has something to teach and something to learn - and that learning from others helps us grow stronger together.

Encouraging curiosity helps to create inclusive communities where everyone feels seen, heard and valued.

Take Aways

Fostering Curiosity

At home, at school & in the community

- **Ask open-ended questions** like "What do you think?", "I wonder..." or "Why?"
- **Try new foods, music or activities** from around the world.
- **Read about or watch stories** from different cultures and talk about what you learned.
- **Attend Cultural Festivals, Museums or Community Events.**
- **Listen with interest - not judgement.** Encourage others to share their experience and perspectives.
